RESOURCE SUPPORT

Who is it for:

Anyone who arrives at Kids Haven's Benoni premises that needs food, clothing, or assistance. It is also for those who attend programmes and go on outings and events run by Kids Haven. People in need may also reach out to Kids Haven via social media. The social worker and community team will make contact and investigate the circumstances to properly understand the need and how we can help.

Where and when:

Daily meal packs, clothing and support is offered to those in need. Our social worker and community team may include a home visit to support the person requesting help.

Key outcome:

To ensure that all those in need in our community receive help.

Cost

- There is no significant cost to Kids Haven for resources. We use donated meals and donated clothing to share with those in need.
- Kids Haven must cover the costs of the social worker and community worker who may make home visits. Their fuel must be covered.

How to help

- **Funding**

Any contribution to the staff team and travel costs is appreciated.

- **Donation items**

Donate meal-in-a-bag ingredients. This is a nutritious meal that is shared with people in need. Donate second hand clothing, and blankets. We appreciate new blankets too. Blankets should be washable.

Toiletries are shared to families, especially those with teenagers in the home.

- **Food vouchers and parcels**

Food vouchers (gift cards for Shoprite or Pick n Pay) or food parcels containing basics like mielie meal, tinned fish, salt and spices, powdered milk, beans, and peanut butter, go a long way to help those in need. We always appreciate this support.

- **Volunteer**

Spend time at Kids Haven assisting with sorting out donations or packing food parcels. There are many jobs that need to be done and all help is most welcome.
