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Kids Haven protects and cares for children in crisis, and empowers families, children and communities to build safe and caring spaces for all.

FORMAL SCHOOL

Who is it for:

Kids Haven ensures that all children living at the Centre attend formal school in the community. Children are expected to attend a local school and to progress alongside their grade cohorts.

Where and when:

Kids Haven uses a network of 24 different schools in Benoni and Daveyton, which ensures that every child is able to attend school and can thrive in the most suitable school. This can mean finding a school where the medium of instruction is Zulu or Sotho or finding a school which offers Afrikaans. We always consider the exit plans of the child as best we can to pick the best school to meet the child's needs so that there is a continuum of care when the child is re-unified with family.

We attend parent-teacher meetings and offer supervised homework sessions at home to support their efforts to get good grades. We encourage every child to remain in school as long as possible – preferably completing Matric.

We also provide all the resources necessary for every child to attend school, including after-school support, extra lessons, remedial lessons, and parent/teacher meetings.

Kids Haven transports the children to and from school daily.

Key outcome:

The goal of the Formal School Programme is for each child to attain the highest grade possible—most particularly Matric—and to be fully integrated into the life of their school, including the extra mural activities offered by their schools.

Additional outcome:

Our Incare children get to integrate and socialise with children in the community, building friendships and enjoying social activities.

Cost:

The annual budget to cover all costs associated with formal school is R833 307 – R469 per month per learner.
